

### Antimicrobial resistant pathogens in poultry meat

### **Environmental impact**



Industrial poultry farming produces high quantities of pollutants

- NH<sub>3 (ammonia)</sub>
- Main source = manure



- Pollutant for air & waterways
- Irritant for eyes and airways of animals and humans
- Only measured in farms with > 40,000 chickens ("splitting" of farms to avoid reporting!)



Industrial poultry farming produces high quantities of pollutants

Fine particulate matter (PM 2.5)

- Complex mixture of very small particles
  and liquid droplets released into the air
- Contains a cocktail of air-borne bacteria and fungi
- Can cause asthma and other respiratory problems in people living nearby industrial poultry units


